Described as "the dogs who glow" by their masters, these smoothcoated, long-legged, red dogs are shown in ancient rock drawings in Egypt hunting wild game with their masters. Their large ears, keen eyes, long legs, sleek coat and stamina make them both a sight and sound hound dog. The coat won't snag on desert brush, and long legged prey like gazelles and ostriches can't outrun them. Today, their breed is known as "Pharaoh Hounds." Crown Prince Thutmose has one of these dogs in the first book. Similarly configured dogs like Salukis may be related, but no other dog "glows."
